

## PROFILE OF TRAINERS & SPEAKERS

### **Dr. Balkees ABDUL MAJEED, MBBS (Madras); MRCP (UK)**

Dr. Balkees received her medical degree from Madras Medical College, University of Madras, India. She obtained her specialist qualification from the Royal College of Physicians (UK) as a paediatrician in 1998 and has since served as a Consultant Paediatrician in Penang Hospital, BM Specialist Hospital, Srigim Women & Children Hospital and currently at Pantai Mutiara Hospital. Dr. Balkees is a certified Lactation Consultant by the International Board of Lactation Consultant Examiners (IBLCE) since 2005 has attended Breastfeeding Advocacy & Practice course conducted by Institute of Child Health, London. She has been actively involved in promoting breastfeeding and has initiated a mother to mother peer support group (MMPS) in Penang. Dr Balkees is World Alliance for Breastfeeding Action (WABA) local governance co-coordinator and she is actively collaborating breastfeeding promotion alongside with organization like UNICEF, WABA and IBFAN.

Prof. Jacqueline Ho is a keen advocate of evidence based medicine and is the coordinator of Malaysian Node of the Cochrane Collaboration. To date, she has over 40 peer-referred articles.
