GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS

1. All researchers and trainees in paediatrics, child health and related fields are welcome to present their researches / case reports during this conference.
2. Each researcher may submit as many abstracts as possible. Participants must register for the conference for their abstract(s) to be accepted. Abstracts selected for oral presentation will be informed in advance.
3. Each abstract should be sent in Microsoft Word document format (*.doc / *.docx) and must not exceed 250 words; excluding the abstracts title, authors and their affiliations.
4. Time allocated for each oral presentation is 10 minutes; including questions and answers.
5. Time allocated for each poster presentation is 3 minutes; including questions and answers.
6. Presentations will be judged by a panel of experts.
7. Posters should be in A0 Size in Portrait (Approximately 118.9cm x 84.1cm).
8. Closing date for abstract submission is 15th January 2017.
